With the flu season and the rise of the H1N1 virus, please remember the following:

ACSTO Reminder

Year end is fast approaching and we want to remind everyone that there is an easy way to make a difference in the life of a child attending Chandler Christian School. CCS teamed up with The Arizona Christian School Tuition Organization, ACSTO, to help raise scholarship funds for students attending CCS.

Through the Tuition Credit Act, you can make a donation to ACSTO that will assist families in achieving their dreams of giving their children a Christian education while taking a dollar-for-dollar CREDIT against your tax liability for the State of Arizona!

The maximum credit for married couples filing is \$1,000.00 or single tax payers \$500.00. If a taxpayer has actual Arizona state income less than the maximum allowable, the available credit in a given year is limited to the actual tax. The law allows a carry forward for up to five years if a donation exceeds their actual tax. A contribution in any amount provides tuition assistance for our students.

Donation cards are available in the school office. Remember, donation cards must be postmarked by Dec. 31 and sent directly to the ACSTO.
