Officer/Committee Reports

Administrator's Report

- Risers are enroute and will be here for Christmas program.
- Dec 16th program: K-2 6pm, 3rd-5th 7:30pm
- 16 students selected for ACSI written qualifier
- 14th school board mtg will have school calendar topic.
 - Proposal of only 1wk of October break => starting school 1 wk later
 - People invited to bring other topics to the mtg
 - Grandparent's Day: 1 relatively cheap idea proposed is to highlight grandparents' talents – testimony, piano piece, etc.
 - Theme for next year: "Forward in Faith"
 - East wing of school may be rented to San Tan Christian Academy, 6th-8th, for 3 yrs. School board approved idea. Church board also approved. Now in negotiation stage. STCA may have access to rooms in Jan.
 - Open house Jan 21st
 - Would be nice if they were ready to show that.
 - Mrs. Zappe will administrate STCA. Will be in charge of faculty and family enrollment, but STCA.
 - Staggered classroom additions – 6th grade, followed by 7th, followed by 8th over 3 years.

 - Need volunteers
 - Need cakes

 - Valley Goldmine, a cash-for-gold business, will have a booth.
 - Food count must be in by Wednesday.

New Business
